

Rules and Regulations Committee Report for 10/15/20 Board Meeting

The Committee is asking the Board to approve the attached documents to be mailed as part of the annual report to the homeowners. The only document that does not need to be mailed is the Parking Violation Warning but it still requires Board approval.

The Committee is also asking the Board to vote on whether to spend \$606 per month for a patrol for parking violation courtesy warnings and whether, if the parking rule is adopted, to spend the \$606 per month for a parking patrol to issue citations for violations of the rule, if adopted. (These amounts may be lessened as word gets out that citations are being issued).

Also, the Committee is glad to report that the Thousand Oaks Police Chief has responded to our letters asking the police to come into the community to curb speeding and the running of stop signs. There have been sightings of police cruisers in our community. Our letters to the Chief of Police and his response are attached.
